1. What is our “OneUp” campaign?

Generally speaking, OneUp is an opportunity for every New Mexican to help transform the lives of our athletes with intellectual disabilities. It aims to encourage statewide participation and the healthy competitive spirit of Special Olympics. We believe that New Mexico is a special place, one where people have each other’s backs when it really counts. Today, it really counts.

2. How does your OneUp donation support Special Olympics New Mexico?

Special Olympics New Mexico provides year-round sports training and athletic competition in a variety of Olympic-type sports for children and adults with intellectual disabilities. In the 2017 legislative session, we lost 100% of our state funding which amounts to 1/3 of our total operating budget, or \$310,000. Without financial support from our community, we will need to cut programs, meaning the games themselves are in jeopardy in New Mexico.
