State Bocce Tournament Setup



Format

The 2019 State Bocce Tournament (Traditional, Unified and Short Court) will be hosted in three sessions using a format similar to the system used to manage and schedule SONM Bowling Tournaments.

- Each session will use 22 courts with three games per court, per session.
- The court number will always match the Division number.
- The Divisions are numbered by the Session, then Division with the Division Number doubling as the Court Assignment.
- For Example: S1-01 means Session 1, Division 1 and Court #1 ... S2-04 means Session 2, Division 4 and Court #4.
- The Bocce Compressed Heats Sheets are all combined into one set and the Sessions/Division headers are color coded .
- Session 1 Session 2 Session 3

Expectations

- Reduce pressure on the awards venue.
- More effective management and event efficiency.
- The Awards venue is clear, or close to it before the next session starts on the scheduled time.

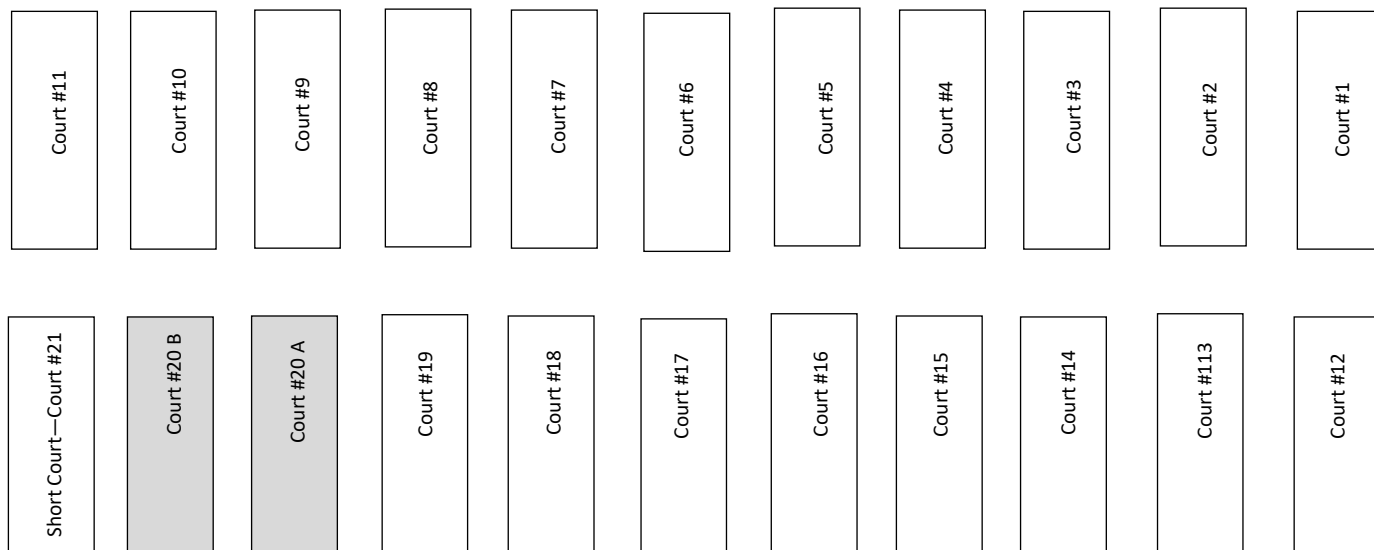

- 66 Games

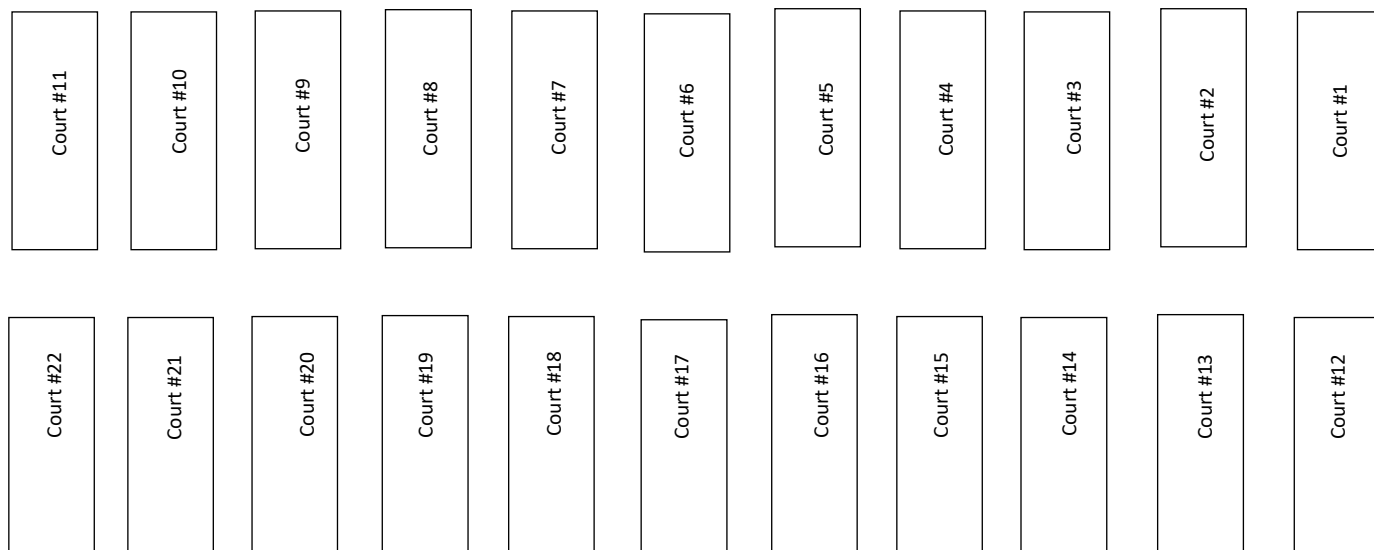
Venue Diagram
